

## Birmingham Society of Botanical Artists – Meeting Venue

How to find us:

Stirchley Baths (Community Centre), 2-4 Bournville Lane, Birmingham B30 2JT

By motorway:

Approaching from the north west or south east along the M6:

- Leave at Junction 6 (signposted Birmingham Central) to join the A38(M)
- At the end of the motorway, keep to the right, go over a flyover, then through some underpasses to join the A38 Bristol Road
- At the traffic light junction with the Birmingham Ring Road, turn left and then right, at the traffic island, on to Pershore Road (A441).
- Follow the Pershore Road through Selly Park to Stirchley.
- When you see the Co-Op store over to your right, continue forward into the one way system.
- At the end of the one way section, turn sharp right and double back towards the Co-Op.
- Stirchley Baths will be on your left, at the junction with Bournville Lane.
- The car park entrance is at the far end of the building on the left.

Approaching from the M42 north:

- Leave at Junction 8 to join the M6 northbound and follow the instructions above .

Approaching from the south - M40 / M42 / M5

- Leave the M5 at Junction 4 signposted Birmingham to join the A38.
- Follow the A38 Bristol Road, passing through Northfield, for about 6 miles.
- Just beyond the pedestrian foot bridge, do a 'U' turn right, then first left to enter Bournville Lane, just ahead of West Midlands Police building.
- Continue along Bournville Lane, crossing Oak Tree Lane and Linden Road, pass the Cadbury works.
- The Stirchley Baths is at the end of Bournville Lane, on the left.
- Turn left on to Pershore Road and then left into the car park.

By bus

- Service # 27—Maypole to Hawksley, alight in Bournville Lane opposite Lea House Road and walk forward along Bournville Lane.
- Service # 38—Northfield to Selly Oak via Cotteridge, service # 45—Birmingham to Longbridge, service 47—Birmingham to Rednal, and service # 146—Birmingham to Alvechurch and Redditch, alight at Bournville Lane for inbound, or at the British Oak pub for

outbound services.

- Check the Network West Midlands website for timetables, local maps, routes etc.

### By Rail

Services to Bournville station, then 10 minute walk down Bournville Lane to junction of Bournville Lane and Pershore Road.

### By coach

There are frequent express coach services to Birmingham from London, Heathrow and Gatwick Airports, and many UK cities. The long-distance coach station is in Digbeth in the city centre. Then by local bus or train services.
